We invite you to take part in the scientific

UN Resolution No. Decree No. 45/106 of 1990 determined that October 1 is celebrated as the International Day of Older Persons. The adoption of this Resolution was preceded by the adoption of the Vienna International Plan of Action on Ageing by the World Assembly on Ageing in 1982, and then by the Madrid International Plan of Action in 2002. The aim of this international activity is to raise awareness about aging, to promote the rights of the elderly, as well as the development of society among all generations, to enable the elderly to participate in activities in society in accordance with their psycho-physical capabilities, to recognize the challenges faced by the elderly population, etc.

The international community has recognized the problem of the world's ageing population, bearing in mind that the world faces the threat that, according to UN data, the global population aged 65 and over will exceed the number of young people aged 15 to 24 by 2030. In addition, it is frightening to predict that the number of elderly people will be twice as high as the number of children under the age of five. According to UN estimates, by 2050 the number of older people aged 65 will reach 1.6 billion of the projected population of 9.7 billion, accounting for 16% of the world's total population.

At the beginning of 2017, the World Health Organization issued guidelines entitled Integrated Care for the Elderly, which stated, among other things, that in the past 50 years, socioeconomic development in the world has been accompanied by a drastic decline in the birth rate and an increase in life expectancy of the world's population. Physiological changes in the elderly increase the risk of chronic diseases, which can make them dependent on other people's care. It is clear that the world needs to prepare and adapt, and above all to face the fact that the world's population is aging.



The aim of this scientific conference is to encourage the participants of the conference to answer a number of questions that arise, especially following:

- How can older people participate equally in all the most important social streams and activities?
- How can society provide the elderly with better living conditions by considering the financial, social, legal, technical-technological, health and every other relevant aspect?
- -How to preserve the dignity of the elderly and create a sense of integration in society?
- How to strengthen the position of older people in society and return them to the role of community leaders and bearers of wisdom?

Hereby we invite you to participate in the XIII International Scientific Conference with your scientific or professional article and contribute to shedding light on this issue.

Scope of work – up to 15 pages of A4 format

Title of the paper – capital letters (Times New Roman 14 Bold)

Subtitles - Lowercase (Times New Roman 12 Bold)

Text – with spacing 1 (Times New Roman 12), in one of the official languages in use in Bosnia and Herzegovina, or in one of the world's foreign languages.

Fusnote - Times New Roman 10

An abstract with keywords that also need to be translated into English.

If the article was written by more than one author, and they are engaged in different institutions, it is necessary to indicate in the footnote which of the listed institutions is represented by each of the listed authors (it is possible to cite more than one institution). It is possible for there to be a maximum of three co-authors of one article, and each (co)author can participate with only one written paper.

Bibliography – cited literature includes bibliographic sources, such as articles, monographs, etc., and is given exclusively in a separate section of the article in the form of a list of references.

#### **REGISTRATION FEE**
